The changes are not too much, and we will guide you through them over the coming weeks.

SITTING - SIGN OF RECEPTIVE ATTENTIVE LISTENING

KNEELING - EXPRESSES HUMILITY AND WORSHIP.

Most important when you are asked to stand during Mass, it is of course if you are able. It's also ok to sit down if that works better for you.

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT.
